News from Bower & Branch

There are two bits of news this month out of Bower & Branch, the e-commerce brand for garden centers that sell online and in store. The first is that Decker's Nursery in Groveport, Ohio, is Bower and Branch's newest Grower Member. The 108-year-old business will be fulfilling online consumer orders for container-grown shrubs and evergreens beginning later this summer. Decker's is recognized as a specialist in grafting and rooting cuttings; they also supply finished plant material.
