## **Plant Foods**

The Espoma Company has been producing natural and organic plant foods for more than 80 years. Over that time, they've added to their offerings a number of products that are plant specific. **Tomato-tone (3-4-6)** addresses the one tomato-growing problem that confounds tomato gardeners the most: blossom end rot. It does this with a formulation that contains 8% calcium. In addition, Tomato-Tone is specifically formulated to help gardeners be successful by producing consistently plump and juicy fruits.

**Holly-tone (4-3-4)** is an industry icon when it comes to plant-specific formulations. Created specifically for acid-loving plants such as hollies, azaleas, rhododendrons, dogwoods and evergreens, in 4-, 8- and 20-lb. bags. **Bulb-tone (3-5-3)** reminds gardeners that bulbs need food, too. The second product is **Miracle-Gro Water Soluble Rose Plant Food**, available in both Garden Feeder (premeasured feeder refill packet) and 1.5- or 5-lb. box form.
