The fabric is tough and durable, but still allows air, water and nutrients to pass through for beautiful results—no herbicides required. The vast majority of plant tags in the HIP Labels lineup are made in the USA, shipping from plants in North Carolina, Tennessee and New Jersey. Not only that, but the raw materials used in the plastic tags come from Wisconsin, Missouri and Indiana, said owner Bob Lovejoy. Treleaf: Zella Wooden Extendable Plant Support

Zella upgrades the aesthetic of any plant while supporting it. And the best part, it's modular—it can be made taller and wider just by adding extensions. Zella is made in Treleaf's workshop in Acworth, Georgia, from U.S.-grown red cedar. They're cut from cedar planks using CNC lasers and the stakes are coated with waterproof coatings.
